life. It is a story that you should study, love, and a story you should know. Today we will study this wonderful story .

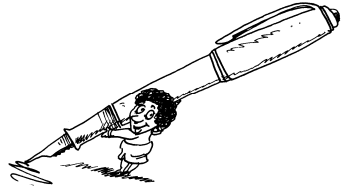

Within the book of Psalms there are many different types of Psalms to be read and studied. There are Psalms of praise, thanksgiving, forgiveness, history, and many more. Also within this book there are prophetic Psalms, one in particular that deals with Jesus and the situation surrounding Him on the cross.

It really is a remarkable piece of prophecy in how specific it gets to what will happen for real, hundreds of years after it was written. Take a look at this piece of Psalm 22:

**14.** *I am poured out like water, And all My bones are out of joint; My heart is like wax; It has melted within Me.*

**15.** *My strength is dried up like a potsherd, And My tongue clings to My Jaws; You have brought Me to the dust of death.*

**16.** *For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet;*

**17.** *I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me.*

**18.** *They divide My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots.*

Although it is incredibly faith building to read a Psalm that speaks of His hands and feet being pierced, and His garments being casted by lots in the Psalms and reading of that happening in the gospel accounts, there is more to be gained from this Psalm. It gives us another opportunity to think and to meditate upon that sacrifice, what it was like, and certainly what it meant to us all. Every day we need to think back to the significance of that sacrifice in our own lives and thank God for doing what He did, in order for our own sins to be washed away, giving us all what we want, hope for a home in heaven.
