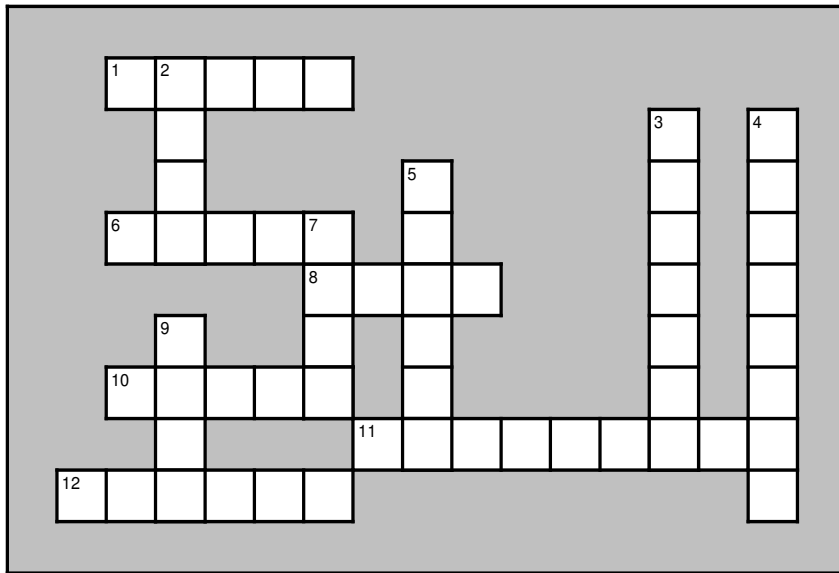

A 3 STEP PROCESS

In today's world everything that we do seems to have some sort of process that is broken down into steps. It may be something you have bought that has instructions on how to assemble it; those instructions will be broken down into steps. It may be a recipe that you are following to cook dinner, there will be a step by step process to follow. It may be a self help book of some kind and the items you would need to follow will be in steps. You see when things are broken up for us in steps it enables us to stay on track, it makes sure we don't leave anything out, and most importantly it makes sure that the item we are working on is completed correctly. So you may ask what about spiritually, is there some sort of step by step process that we can follow that can lead us to heaven. The answer to that question is, **ABSOLUTELY!** There is a simple 3 step process that everyone wishing to enter into heaven must follow, and the steps must be followed in order, and not one of the steps can be skipped. The 3 steps are as follows:

Step #1 - Out Of Self (Matt. 16:24)

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.

Step #2 - Into Christ (Rom. 6:3,4)

Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Step #3 - Into Glory (Rev. 14:13)

Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, "Write: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Yes," says the Spirit, "that they may rest from their labors, and their works follow them."
